The Land and Water Summit

The Land and Water Summit, created in 1986 by the Xeriscape Council of New Mexico, was developed to bring together design professionals, construction and management companies, agencies, farmers, artists, teachers, hydrologists, ranchers, climatologists, wildlife advocates, homeowners, and policymakers to find sustainable ways to protect and share our state's water and resources. Ciudad Soil and Water Conservation District, the Land and Water Summit's fiscal agent, hosts the event.

Land and Water Summit planning committee members are experts highly experienced in utilizing and promoting native and arid-adapted plants, rainwater harvesting, low impact/recycled building materials, and landscaping/ irrigation methods. The group's primary goal is to educate the public about resource conservation and best practices for improving and protecting local landscapes.

The Ciudad Soil and Water Conservation District (CSWD), a political subdivision of the state of New Mexico, promotes the conservation, improvement, and responsible use of the natural resources on the rural and urban lands within its boundaries, including control and prevention of soil erosion; prevention of sediment and floodwater damage; furthering the conservation, development, beneficial application and proper disposal of water; promoting the use of impounded water for recreation, propagation of fish and wildlife, irrigation, and for urban and industrial needs; and, by the application of those measures, conserving and developing the natural resources of the state, providing for flood control, preserving wildlife, protecting the tax base, and promoting the health, safety and general welfare of the people of New Mexico.
